

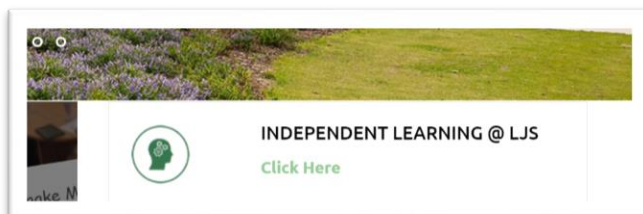


HOME LEARNING DURING SCHOOL CLOSURE

What is in place to support your child during school closure?

Staff have been working hard to provide paper copies of learning resources to students during this uncertain time. In the event of school closure, and where practically possible, work will be sent from class teachers to student email accounts and/or Microsoft teams class groups. All students have been reminded how to access these during registrations this week. Please note email contact from subject teachers may be impacted by personal or family health circumstances.

Students can access work available for specific year groups via the independent learning area of the school website. A student guide on how to access work from home is also available in the independent learning section, alongside resources for all subjects. Please note at this time the independent learning section is under development and will be continually updated over the coming weeks.





YEAR GROUP SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Y10 Students:

- Students will have specific work set for them by their class teachers.
- Work may include online tutorials, revision booklets, other activities for students to complete at home; some paper copies have already been provided to support work set.
- This work will be sent electronically via student emails/Microsoft teams.
- Staff will communicate work with students either via email and/or Microsoft teams.
- Students have received information on how to access these to support remote communication during closure.
- Year 10 should also focus on revision for their Y10 exams which are still scheduled to take place in the summer term.

KS3 students:

- Work will be set for Year 7, 8 and 9 students via the resources on the independent learning section of the website.
- Paper resources have been provided by some subjects to support this work.
- This work may be sent electronically via student emails/Microsoft teams.
- Students have received information on how to access these to support remote communication during closure.
