Destinations (Top 2)

Most popular destination was FE College (145 students) (59.6%) of students a 0.8% increase from last year.

Second most popular destination was Sixth Form College with (72 students) (29.6%) of students choosing this pathway. A % decrease from the previous year.

Projected NEET figure stood at 0 students 0%.

Qualification Levels

Total number of Y11 students - 243

- 65.4% (159 students) progressed onto L3 courses (% decrease on last year)
- 22.6% (55 students) progressed onto L2 courses
- 6.9% (17 students) progressed onto L1 course
- 2.46% (6 students) progressed on Entry Level courses

Providers

Middlesbrough College remains the preferred provider for a mix of A level and vocational study with 30.7% (109 students)

attending. 29.6% (72 students) students attending Prior Pursglove showing an increase of 0.2% in comparison to the previous year.

Overall students progressed into 17 different providers.

Sectors

The latest Labour Market Information for the North East (August 2020) confirms that the top growth industries / sectors across the area are Teaching and Education, Health & Social Work, Professional Services, Construction, Information Technology, Wholesale & Retail, and Finance and Insurance. Covid-19 will have inevitably had an impact on these sectors however the sectors of interest show that students moved into areas of study which reflect an understanding of local LMI, specifically around Engineering (Advanced Manufacturing) and Construction and Health and Social Care
