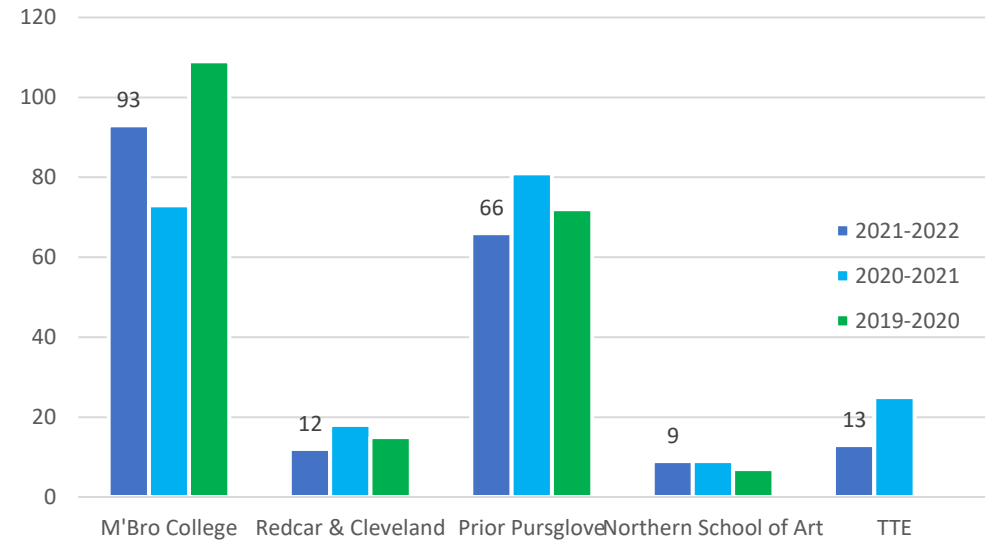

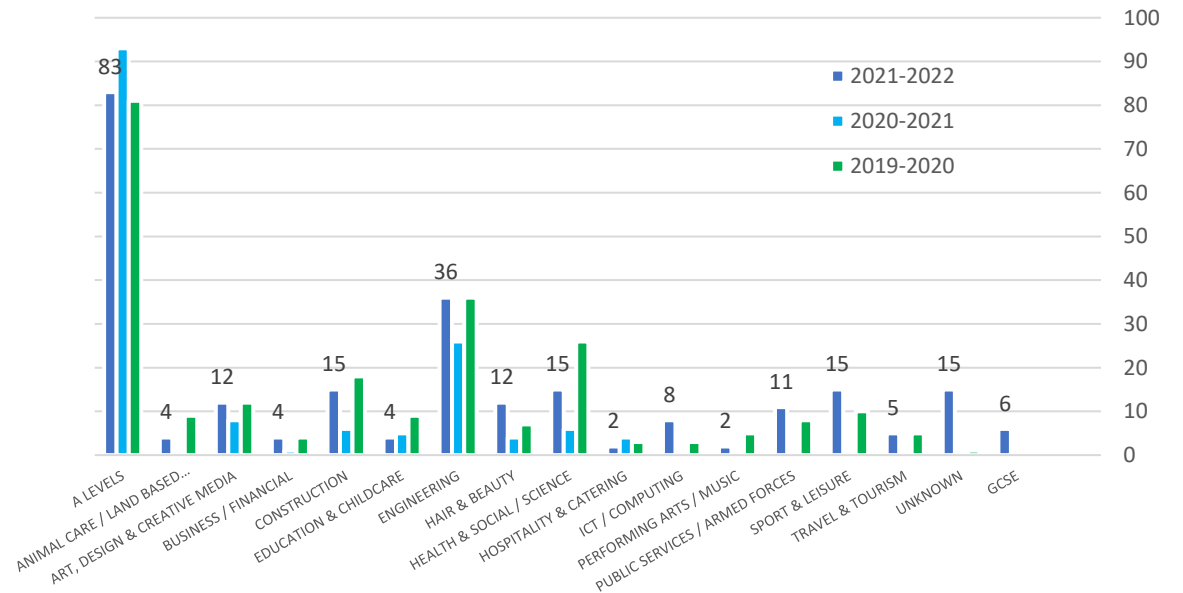

Destinations (Top 2)

Most popular destination was FE College (123 students) (49.3%) of students.

Second most popular destination was Sixth Form College with (67 students) (26.9%) of students choosing this pathway.

Projected NEET figure stood at 6 students *2.4%.

Qualification Levels

Total number of Y11 students - 249

- 64% (161 students) progressed onto L3 courses (8% decrease on last year)
- 22.4% (56 students) progressed onto L2 courses
- 7.6% (19 students) progressed onto L1 course
- 0.8% (2 students) progressed on Entry Level courses
- 4.4% (11 students) were unknown

Providers

Middlesbrough College remains the preferred provider for a mix of A Level and vocational study with 37.3% (93 students) attending. Prior Pursglove enrolled 26.5% (66 students) students which is an increase from last year.

Overall students progressed into 33 different providers.

Sectors

The latest Labour Market Information for the NorthEast (August 2021) confirms that the top growth industries / sectors across the area are Teaching and Education, Health & Social Work, Professional Services, Construction, Information Technology, Wholesale & Retail, and Finance and Insurance. Covid-19 will have inevitably had an impact on these sectors however the sectors of interest show that students moved into areas of study which reflect an understanding of local LMI, specifically around Engineering (Advanced Manufacturing) and Construction and Health and Social Care
