



School Uniform and Presentation Expectations Reminders

- All uniform is available from Trutex or can be purchased from Bambini in Guisborough.
- Trutex offer an online service and the electronic brochure is accessible via the school website.

Uniform Expectations

Please see details of our uniform expectations below. Students must wear:

- A Laurence Jackson School blazer. This is a compulsory item of uniform and must be worn at all time
- A Laurence Jackson School year group specific tie. This tie stripe colour will remain with your child throughout their time at school. School ties are available from our uniform suppliers Trutex and Bambini, as well as from the main school office at a cost of £6.50. All other year groups tie colours remain the same as they currently wear. We recommend that your child has a spare tie. For next year tie colours are as follows. Please ensure your child has the correct colour for their year group (below for 2024-2025):

Y7	Dark green tie with maroon stripe
Y8	Dark green tie with blue stripe
Y9	Dark green tie with gold stripe
Y10	Dark green tie with green stripe
Y11	Dark green tie with black stripe

- A white shirt, which may be long or short sleeved.
- Black trousers or the skirt detailed below. Trousers may be slim or straight fitting but must not be skin-tight. **Jeans, jeggings or leggings are not acceptable.**
- A pleated jubilee tartan skirt. Skirts must be knee length and may only be purchased from our uniform suppliers. **No other styles of skirts are allowed.** Skirts must be worn with plain black rights that are at least 60 deniers.
- Socks must be black, white or grey.

Jumpers are an **optional** item of uniform. Students in Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8 and 9) may choose to wear a plain green V neck jumper under their blazer and in Years 10 and 11 may choose to wear a plain black V neck jumper. Trutex sell plain jumpers with the school logo although a completely plain jumper of the appropriate style and colour is also permitted. **However, a jumper is not an alternative to the school blazer;** students are required to wear blazers at all times.



The illustrations below indicate the uniform expectations.

Footwear

Footwear must be plain black, sensible and practical.

The following types of footwear are not allowed:

- Any type of canvas footwear.
- Designer leisure leather upper footwear. (Examples of these shoes are Vans, Converse, Nike, or any other shoes with highly visible brand names).
- Trainers of any kind.
- Boots.
- Any footwear with stripes or logos.

Students also need a school bag to carry their equipment and books that is big enough to contain A4 books and folders.

PE Kit Expectations

Students are expected to wear the full, correct PE kit during every PE lesson. Students must be prepared to go outside and bring appropriate outdoor clothing to go underneath their PE kit. Students can wear an appropriate hat and gloves if they wish. Please ensure that all of your child's items of clothing and personal property (including inhalers) are clearly labelled with their name.

Tops:

- Black, green and white polo shirt with school logo.
- Black, green and white reversible top with school logo (required for contact sports such as rugby) OR a black, green and white hoody with school logo – rugby top with school logo and hoodie with school logo optional

Bottoms:

- Plain black shorts, black tracksuit bottoms or plain black leggings.
- Plain black or white football socks or sports socks.
- Shin pads to be worn for football.

Footwear:

- Suitable sports trainers for indoor and outdoor activities.
- Moulded studs only for AstroTurf lessons; please note that NO metal blades or metal studs can be worn on the AstroTurf pitch.

Students are encouraged to wear base layers under their school PE kit for outdoor lessons.

Other Presentation Expectations

Students are not permitted to wear false or acrylic or gel nails / nail varnish

Students may wear a single stud earring in each ear **but no other piercings are permitted**

Rings, bracelets and necklaces are not permitted
