This communication clarifies arrangements as we approach our final days together and some final messages.

## Monday 20 June

Y11 students will officially start study leave and only be expected to attend school for exams from Tuesday 21 June onwards.

A final leavers event is planned at lunchtime on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June; details of this event are below.

9.00am	Chemistry Exam	Students complete their chemistry exam in full school uniform – there will be time later in the day to sign shirts using a separate shirt that students have brought in from home. <b>Please note graffiti on clothing could affect a student's entry in to the Chemistry exam and their remaining exams.</b>
Approx 10.15am onwards  <i>*exam finish dependent</i>	Social time as a year group	Students will enjoy a BBQ lunch together and some much-needed social time as year group to say their final goodbyes. Y11 form tutors will be part of this event with students. *Please note for the BBQ students will need to ensure there is enough money on their School Gateway account to purchase food and drinks (at least £2.20).  This time will allow for photos, leavers' books and signing of spare shirts that students have been brought from home. <b>Please note students will need full correct school uniform for the remainder of their exams.</b>
11.30am	Y11 Final Leavers' assembly in main hall	Students will sit in their forms in the assembly hall for the final time and enjoy the memories shared via our final school farewell assembly. Student will be given their records of achievement and form tutor references at the end of this assembly.
12.15pm approx		Students will be dismissed from the main hall fire door to begin their official study leave. Any parent collecting their child should wait in the bottom bus lane area of school.

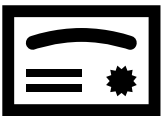
