HPV Immunisation Information — FAO Parents / Carers of Year 8 students

Please access this [link](#) from Intra Health which shares information regarding the HPV vaccination that will be available to Year 8 students in school on 23 April. Previously this vaccination was a 2-dose schedule however now due to the effectiveness of the vaccine now only one dose is required. For most of your children, this is the first time they will have received an IM (intramuscular) injection without your presence, and some children may not remember having one at all. Electronic consent forms have been shared with you previously, but the link is here also [Session Form | eConsent Client \(nhsimms.azurewebsites.net\)](#) – this link will close on 16th April. Please note that you must either consent or decline the vaccination invitation - it is not just consent only. If you have any queries, please call the immunisation team directly on the details provided below. Please note that school do not have access to the consent link or medical records.
