CURRICULUM

Key Stage 3 Home Learning - All students will be shown this slide on Monday. To support your child with good routines, please try to sit with them and write when they will do their Sparx learning across the week to fit in around their personal commitments. Place their plan somewhere visible at home and remind your child to check Class Charts, crossing off their plan as they complete their tasks; then review this with your child at the end of the week.

The following Home Learning Tasks are due in this week:


- Sparx Reader from last week (Today)

Important date for Y10: Tuesday 20th January (Practice Exam Day) - In order to support Y10 with the GCSE exam process we intend to conduct some of their coming assessments in the sports hall so that they can practice sitting exams in formal conditions. These assessments in Maths and English are usually completed in classrooms but we are going to use this opportunity to do these assessments in actual GCSE exam venues. Y10 have already had an exam conduct assembly to explain the processes for these exams and pastoral staff will support them throughout. Students will attend school as normal but will not attend any lessons on this day. The day will be as follows so that students can begin to experience exam conduct for GCSE exams as part of their journey over KS4.
